# Loch Lomond Shores from Balloch Station (walk)

## Route Summary

A traffic-free walking route from Balloch Rail Station to the Loch Lomond Shores complex. It follows the west bank of the River Leven to Loch Lomond.

## Description

This route is mainly traffic free and starts just across the road from the Rail Station. On leaving the station, the Visitor Centre can be seen across the road in a fine old stone building. Worth a visit to gather information on local facilities. Just along from the Visitor Centre a road bridge crosses the river. Before the bridge, turn



left, go through the car park and join the wide footpath that runs close to the river to Loch Leven. On reaching the loch vicinity, one can either turn right to go to the Waverley steam ship or carry straight onto the Shores retail and leisure complex.

## Waypoints

---

### **Balloch Station**

(56.00265; -4.58358)



Use the exit at the end of the platform. The Visitor Centre for Balloch is just across the road in the largest stone-built house.

### **Black Road**

(56.00292; -4.58381)



Turn right on leaving the station and take the footpath through the car park and before the bridge.

### **John Muir Way**

(56.00328; -4.582...)



Take a left and follow the footpath and subsequently the road that runs parallel to the river.

### Pedestrian Area

(56.00693; -4.58887)



At this point there is the option to go to the right to take a boat trip along Loch Lomond

### Lomond Shores retail outlets

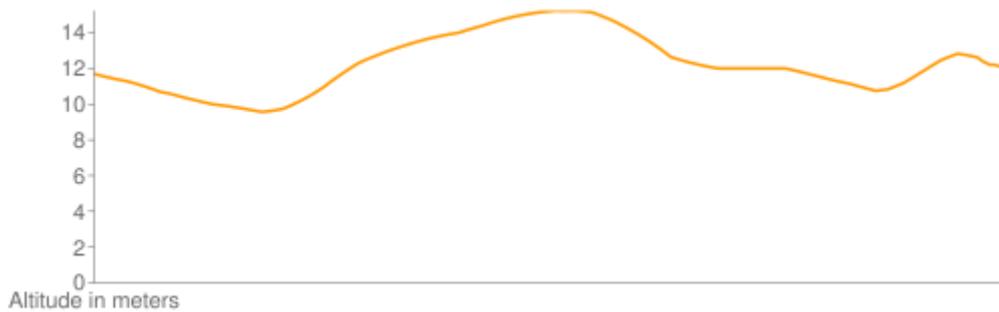
(56.00579; -4.59033)
