Description

A short route, but with a steep climb out of the Waverley Valley up to the Old Town. The route heads up



Market street, past the Bank of Scotland building and the crosses the Royal Mile. After going along George IV Bridge, the museum is on the left.

Waypoints

Exit Waverley Station

(55.95173; -3.19019)

Head up the South Ramp out of Waverley Railway Station.

Waverley Bridge

(55.95152; -3.19161)



Turn left on to Waverley Bridge.

Market Street

(55.95089; -3.19132)



At the roundabout, turn right and head up the hill on to Market Street.

 **Turn left at top of Market Street**

(55.95016; -3.19474)



Turn left at the lights.

 **North Bank Street**

(55.95002; -3.19439)



Continue up North Bank Street

Bank Street

(55.94999; -3.19289)



The street curves to the right and continues on to Bank Street upwards to the junction with the Royal Mile.

 **Chambers Street**

(55.94711; -3.19127)



Turn left on to Chambers Street.

Museum of Scotland entrance


(55.94706; -3.19075)

The 'Museum of Scotland' entrance is on the corner. It is connected internally to the older National Museum of Scotland building so you can enter here or walk a short distance to the main entrance.
