Description

The first section of the suggested route requires walking the bike on the pavement as it use the path down to Abbey Road which is one way in the opposite direction. You can instead cycle the whole way by turning left on Station Road and then right at the traffic lights (Station Hill) which will join the cycle route below at Westgate/Beach Road. From there it's an easy route through town. Traffic is not fast, and the route is



relatively flat.

Waypoints


Exit the station

(56.05710; -2.73026)

From the end of the platform, continue straight ahead on the pavement beside the car park until you reach the road (Station Road).

Station Road

(56.05765; -2.72938)



Turn right and go to the signal crossing.

Cross the road

(56.05747; -2.72886)



The path is just to the left of the crossing.

Pedestrian path

(56.05756; -2.72874)



Head down the path towards town; you may have to walk your bike if there are pedestrians using it.

Abbey Road

(56.05769; -2.72791)



Continue along Abbey Road.

 **Westgate**

(56.05809; -2.72652)



Turn left on Westgate and cycle in that direction for a short distance until it curves around to Beach Road.

 **Beach Road**

(56.05847; -2.72756)

Follow the road around to the right to Beach Road. Stay on the road until the junction with Victoria Road.

 **Victoria Road**

(56.05931; -2.71727)



Take a left on Victoria Road, signed for the Seabird Centre.

← Path to the Seabird Centre

(56.06039; -2.71754)



Follow the curve at the end of the road and then stop at the path to the Seabird Centre. If there are lots of pedestrians you will need to walk your bike up this path.


Parking bollards are available outside the Seabird Centre.


